

Sackville Snow Days Parade 2020

Parade Instructions / Policy

Once again the Sackville Community Development Association is thrilled to host a parade for Sackville Snow Days.

The parade is on Monday, February 17, 2020. It marches off at 2pm from the Sackville Legion on Sackville Cross Road, proceeds to Sackville Drive, turns right, and continues to the Rock Church. The entire parade route will be closed at 1:45pm.

The rules for the parade are:

1. All entries form up at the Legion parking lot, 45 Sackville Cross Road, no later than 1:30pm. We may use overflow parking lots.
2. As you arrive at the Legion parking lot you will be directed to your location in the line up by the Parade Marshall or someone working with him. The entries will have been organized in advance to allow for the best presentation of the entries and the most enjoyment by our community.
3. The parade is single file procession. If you are walking then please stay with your entry.
4. Please maintain a constant forward speed of about 2.5 km/hr and stay within 25 to 100 feet of the entry ahead of you. Hopefully there will be no stops. When one entry stops all of the following entries need to stop. If you are able to maintain the pace or if you have a mechanical break down during the parade then the entry must be withdrawn from the line-up immediately.
5. Leaders of groups are responsible for children participating in their entry before, during, and after the parade. Small children, in or out of vehicles, must be accompanied adults.
6. Entries such as pick-up trucks, vans, non-float entries and commercial entries must be decorated. Vehicles must be clean, neat, and in safe condition. The only entries that do not require decoration are classic or antique vehicles, like cars, tractors, or stage coaches.
7. All entries should be well identified (front and both sides of a vehicle if possible) for the pleasure of all the parade watchers.
8. Nothing (candies, balloons, advertising etc.) is to be thrown from entries. Items can be distributed only from people accompanying the entry and walking along with the entry.
9. Any business sponsoring an entry is responsible for picking up their banner or other belongings after the parade.
10. The parade ends after about 1.5km at the Rock Church parking lot, 222 Sackville Drive. If you leave the Rock Church parking lot before the parade is completed you must turn right onto Sackville Drive.
